LADY T was unhurried early, rallied two wide between rivals into the stretch, took over entering the final furlong, bore out under left hand whip then was straightened away. SHULANA made the early pace while racing close to the inside and weakened. DANCE WINNER was fractious in the gate then was bumped after the break, raced two wide around the final turn, moved closer in early stretch then flattened out. SISTER SUZIE SLEW was rated not far back along the inside, gave her best on the final turn and into the stretch then tired. GALEZERONI showed speed inside, came out three wide to vie on the final turn then stopped. LADY CONVEYOR was bumped between rivals at the break then showed speed briefly and stopped. DUKE'S SHOW BIZ was outrun. GABBY DANCER showed speed to the far turn then stopped. SEVEN CHIMES stopped. NORTHERN MISSION was outrun.
