ENGLISH GIRL was close up and four wide on the turn, reached contention the entered into a long drive and prevail. TAKE ME AWAY TODAY stalked the early pace, raced three wide and contended on the turn, then dueled to the wire but gave way. PENNY'S BOAT vied for a share of the lead from along the inside through the turn, then weakened in the stretch. TERLINGUA'S CAUSE pressed the pace from the two path through the turn, then faded late. LUNA GRANDE was close up early, raced inside through the turn, then failed to sustain that bid. HARD TO STEAL showed good early speed, raced three wide on the turn, then was through after a half. SOPHIA'S SO SASSY lacked speed, raced two wide on the turn then was outrun. ROYALE HARBOR stumbled at the start, raced three wide on the turn then was eased to the wire.
