Footnotes

BUNNY BLIZZARD set the pace with a clear lead, saved ground throughout and finished under urging. BARCAZA was slow early, raced two wide on the turn, then rallied late and finished second best. SEASONS CHANGE was void of early speed, raced three wide through the turn, then closed ground willingly. IRON STONE RIDGE pressed the pace from the start, raced inside through the turn, then weakened late. BLITZENSTEEKLDPINK was close up early, raced three wide on the turn and drifted at the 1/4 pole then lacked a late response. LADY JUNIOR was close up early, raced inside on the turn then tired in the stretch. ART SERIES saved ground on the turn and failed to menace. ALL WE ARE SAYING showed brief speed, raced three wide on the turn then faltered in the stretch. LADYLUCK stalked the early pace, raced two wide on the turn then flattened out. ORIOLE saved ground but trailed the field.
