SAFARI ARTIE set the pace from the start, saved ground throughout and finished under urging. KELLY ROCK stalked the pace from along the inside through the last turn, was no match for the winner in the drive but clearly second best. ALPHA RED was unhurried early, raced along the inside on the far turn, then found his best stride late. LUF TO pressed the early pace, raced three wide through the far turn, then lacked a late response. TUCKED IN FRONT was close up early, raced two wide on the last turn, then failed to sustain his bid. IMAGINARYWEEKEND prompted the early pace, raced two wide on the second turn, then faded late. ENGLISH BLOKE stalked the early pace, raced two wide on the last turn and faltered. AVILORD saved ground but failed to menace. JAMES LEE raced four wide on the far turn and was never a factor. MANDLA lacked speed, raced two wide on the far turn and showed little. RIDLEY CREEK ROAD saved ground but trailed from the start.
