STAN'S MONEY was unhurried early, rallied two wide around the turn, angled out through the lane, took over past midstretch and drove clear late. OMRICON was slow from the gate then was unhurried, rallied well out from the rail around the turn and finished with good energy outside. STOLEN PARCEL raced the three path around the turn and lacked a strong closing. MO'S CUTTER wasn't far back outside, moved to vie two wide on the turn, dueled to midstretch then weakened. SMALL GIANT held a short lead along the inside to the stretch and faded. OUR HAE was slow to settle, raced three wide around the turn and made up ground late. HOT UNDER PRESSURE fell back inside on the turn and continued evenly late. GAMBINE ROAD stayed close to the front while out from the rail then tired. TRUE TO THE LADIES was outrun. FREE FRANKIE was wide and outrun. ELLE JOUET showed speed between rivals, angled to the rail on the turn and stopped. PENSYLVANIAKING was outrun.
