FOR FILLIES & MARES, THREE-YEARS-OLD AND UPWARD. No Nomination Fee. \$500 to pass the entry box, \$500 additional to start. Supplemental nominations of \$2,000 will be accepted at time of entry which shall include all fees. The purse to be distributed: \$1000 to all starters; with the balance of the purse to be divided, 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth, 3% to fifth. Weights: Three Years Olds, 118 lbs.; Older, 122 lbs. Non-winners of a Sweepstakes at a mile or over on the turf in 2012, allowed 2 lbs.; \$30,000 at a mile or over in 2012, 4lbs.; \$25,000 at one mile or over in 2012, 6lbs. Maiden and Claiming races not considered in estimating allowances. (Highweights Preferred.) (Horses of equal weight, preference will be total earnings in non-claiming races in 2011 and 2012.) Close Wednesday, July 18, 2012 with 43 Nominations. (Rail at 0 feet) (If deemed inadvisable by management to run this race over the turf course, it will be run on the main track at One Mile and One Sixteenth.)

MARTITA SANGRITA stalked the pace from along the inside through the last turn, then angled outward at the top of the stretch and rallied to prevail at the wire. CLARE SKIES AHEAD was unhurried early, raced along the two path on the far turn then angled outward and closed ground willingly. SAFE CROSSING set the pace from the start, held a clear lead while saving ground to mid stretch, then weakened late. THUNDERING EMILIA pressed the pace from the start, raced two wide on the second turn, then tired in the stretch. ASK ME ANYTHING raced three wide on the second turn and failed to menace. MASTER SHADE (ITY) was close up early, raced three wide on the last turn, then faded late. COZMAYA saved ground but trailed throughout.
