MIDAS TERMS set the pace from the start, raced along the two path through the far turn, held a clear lead throughout and finished under urging. BARRY MEATBALL was unhurried early, raced four wide on the second turn, then rallied late but was no match for the winner. LEGENDARY BRAVERY was close up and three wide on the second turn but lacked a late response. BLAZING BOY pressed the pace from the start, raced three wide on the far turn, then weakened late. TOUR THE PLACE was close up early, raced two wide on the second turn, then lacked a rally. ONE LESS AFFAIR was slow early, raced inside on the second turn and was not a threat. RESOLUTE ACE was void of early speed, raced three wide on the last turn and showed little throughout. TRI'S HERO pressed the early pace, raced along the inside and faded on the far turn. CITY SKY lacked speed, raced inside on the second turn and was not a factor. PARADE IN BRAZIL was close up early, raced two wide on the second turn, then flattened out in the stretch.
