LET THE BELLS RING moved clear from the inside entering the turn and was under steady urging. PERFECT NEW (JPN) pressed outside the winner early, angled to the inside on the turn and continued evenly. THE BLACK ONE was caught in tight along the rail approaching the lane, angled out and finished willingly outside. SCORPIO DOG was caught in tight soon after the break, raced three wide into the stretch and continued evenly. SUNSHINE PLATINUM made a mild two wide run on the turn and continued evenly. NATIVE MANDATE was in tight early and again inside nearing the stretch then tired. THERE GOES TRIPPI was outrun after a slow start. MY DEAR BILLY was finished early. ROCKINANRACIN showed speed then stopped.
