### Footnotes

BROOMER was never far back, raced inside on the second turn, then angled out in the stretch and rallied late drawing off while under urging. GRANITE DUST pressed the pace early, raced to contention on the backstretch then drew clear while saving ground but was outfinished late. BORN A HERO was unhurried early, raced three wide on the last turn, then made a late bid for show. OUT OF THE FIRE was slow early, raced inside on the second turn, then closed willingly. JOY'S GRAND REWARD set the pace from the start, was headed early then then raced two wide through the last turn and faded in the stretch. SIMBA BAHARI pressed the pace from the start, raced three wide on the far turn the faltered in the stretch. YIELD AT THE BULL was close up early, raced two wide on the far turn, then tired in the stretch. DOMESTIC TRUCE was close up early, raced two wide on the last turn then faded late. CHEMICAL AL lacked speed, raced along the rail on the far turn and showed little. PEANUT HALLIDAY raced along the two path through the second turn and trailed throughout.
