GHOSTWRITER stalked the pace from the three path through the turn, contended at the 1/4 pole then drew off under urging. NAVY SEAL SIX pressed the pace from the three path through the turn, then rallied late but was no match for the winner. CHASE THE UNKNOWN was close up early, raced inside on the turn then angled outward and made a late bid. OSISKO vied for the lead from along the inside through the turn, then gave way in the stretch. TOMMY V M vied for the lead from the two path through the turn then faltered late. MARKET TIDE lacked speed, raced two wide on the turn and showed little. BUBBA SYSTEM was slow early, raced inside on the turn and was never a threat. MURDOCK raced two wide on the turn, lacked speed and was outrun.
