SNOW HILL was slow from the gate, rallied the rail around the turn, awaited room approaching the stretch, came out between horses after five furlongs and was along in time. DECOLATOR was slow to settle, raced two wide outside the winner around the turn, swung out entering the stretch and finished gamely. TITRANIUM raced three wide with the pace into the final strides then was caught. CANDY GAMES angled to the rail on the turn while with the pace and gave way late. BILLY BELMONT stayed inside around the turn and lacked a rally. GONE AWESOME raced two wide with the pace for over five furlongs then weakened. ONEMOREFORARCH was caught behind the leaders on the backstretch, swung out leaving the turn and tired. REDORWHITE was outrun. SAYERS stopped.
