VIRGINIA DREAM was never far back outside, stayed well out from the rail around the turn, rallied to the front from the outside in late stretch and quickly drew out. LA FEMME took over just after the break, came out from the rail early and couldn't contain the winner. CLASSE SIGNORA had position inside but lacked a rally. COUNTESS EMMA fell back after an alert start, raced two wide around the turn, edged out in the stretch and finished gamely. A WINK AND A SMILE pressed the early leader from the outside then weakened. SMARTYS EMPERRESS lagged early, came out two wide on the turn and made up some ground. MISS HARD TEN was unhurried early, was caught in tight nearing the end of the backstretch, came outside and continued evenly. CLOSER TO LOVE was slow from the gate, moved up between rivals, angled to the inside on the turn then stopped.
