WEEPER broke the gate before the start then stalked outside, moved to the front on the turn and drew out through the final sixteenth. GRAY GOWN faltered inside. MINERS PUNCH came well out from the rail nearing the stretch, moved closer into the final furlong then flattened out. BANG AWAY was slow to settle, angled in to be out from the rail into the stretch and lacked a closing. BOSTONWEDDINGBELL tired outside. OWIN SYLVIA was outrun two wide. MAKES ME WONDER was slow from the gate then saved ground in an even effort. LAVENDER ROMP was outrun inside. SUBDUE was caught wide around the turn and tired. SUNSHINE RADIANCE briefly showed speed. DELROY'S BARMAID was outrun.
