FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS. No Nomination Fee. \$500 to pass the entry box with an additional \$500 to start. Supplemental nominations of \$2,000 will be accepted at time of entry which shall include all fees. The purse to be distributed: \$1000 to all starters; with the balance of the purse to be divided, 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth, and 3% to fifth. Weights: 122 lbs. Non-winners of a Sweepstakes at one mile or over in 2011, allowed, 2 lbs.; \$25,000 twice at a mile or over in 2011, 4 lbs. (Maiden and Claiming races not considered in estimating allowances). Closed Wednesday, July 20, 2011 with 36 Nominations. (If deemed inadvisable by management to run this race over the turf course it will be run on the main track at One Mile. If more than 10 horses remain it will be run at One Mile and Seventy Yards.)

LIVE IN JOY was rated out from the rail in good position, moved to vie outside nearing the stretch, took over in midstretch and drove clear late. CRIMSON KNIGHT cleared before going a furlong then angled to the inside, responded gamely when challenged then gave way grudgingly. KENTUCKY REIGN trailed early, began a run between horses after a half, raced two wide around the final turn and finished with good energy. ST. IVAN was unhurried early, raced three wide around the final turn and made up some ground. GRANT JACK wasn't far back two wide into the far turn then weakened. SLEW CITY BOY stayed inside and failed to menace. PRIME OBJECTIVE came out on the backstretch while chasing the early leader then tired.
