**Footnotes**

NEFERTITI was unhurried inside, came out four wide on the final turn while moving, took over from the outside entering the final furlong and proved narrowly best after a stiff drive. SOPHIA'S SO SASSY steadied in tight along the rail nearing the backstretch then steadied and altered course between rivals entering the far turn, swung out entering the stretch and finished willingly outside. RUNAWAY SUZANNA was slow to settle, rallied four wide around the final turn and finished fast outside. LA GRAN RUBY was caught wide around the first turn, remained prominent three wide into the final furlong then weakened late. DRAMATICA trailed to the stretch then finished fastest outside. REGINA TWAIN wasn't far back, steadied in tight between rivals on the backstretch, angled to the inside entering the final turn then weakened. MON CHOU made the early pace two wide then tired. BAHIA BEACH failed to menace. AFILLYATION was in tight between rivals on the first turn and again nearing the far turn then faded. MARK UP TINY showed speed inside, then had to take up and come out to avoid heels when REGINA TWAIN dropped to the rail entering the far turn and was eased up.
