**Footnotes**

BEN'S CAT settled while racing out from the rail, edged out for room in early stretch, brushed PHILLY BOUND then closed with a rush once clear and was along in time. CARDASHI took over soon after the break, stayed inside, held gamely into the final yards but couldn't last. CAR THIEF pressed the early leader two wide but couldn't gain. AWAKINO CAT was slow to settle, stayed along the rail into the stretch then angled out and finished fast. PHILLY BOUND had position three wide but lacked a rally. BUBBER was squeezed back leaving the gate then trailed to the stretch and finished with good energy. SNEAKING OPONYOU was never far back inside, steadied while awaiting room approaching the lane, came through the inside once clear then flattened out. LOCAL CELEBRITY was steadied in tight after the break, raced well out from the rail and lacked a rally. TOWZEE (NZ) raced four wide around the turn while not far back then tired. JR'S EXCHANGE came in sharply leaving the gate then faded.
