Footnotes

GOD'S GRACE was never far back, raced three wide on the backstretch, reached contention late and closed under urging. GRACIE'S GAZE raced along the inside on the far turn, angled out at the 1/4 pole and rallied late from the outside, finishing well. FLEETING DISPLAY pressed the pace from the three path throughout and tired late. VOXTEN ANGEL trailed to mid stretch while racing three wide on the turns and passed tiring rivals late. LIL KINKO was slow early, raced three wide on the second turn and was not a factor. MISS FIRETHORN failed to menace. SPARKLIN SILVER broke alertly, stalked the pace from along the inside, reached contention late then faltered. VICTORIAN PRINCESS set the early pace, was pressured throughout while racing along the inside and faded in the drive.
