

### Footnotes

TANGIER SOUND showed speed outside from the start, edged clear then angled to the rail early on the turn and remained clear under a hand ride. GO GO BABY GO moved up the rail to engage the winner early, fell back entering the turn then continued evenly to the end. An objection by Elliott against the winner alleging interference entering the turn was not allowed. ALL THAT GLITTERS was unhurried after a slow break, raced three wide around the turn, swung out in early stretch and finished fastest. OH SAY VICKI had position in the three path but came up empty. SCOOTIN' GIRL was slow to find best stride. MAYPOLE DANCE wasn't far back along the inside but lacked a rally. ACHARI wasn't far back early, was caught four wide around the turn and weakened in the lane. CHORDS OF FAME raced three wide and failed to menace. MARQUEE KELLY was put in tight after the break then was caught in tight along the rail nearing the stretch. MALVERN ROSE raced two wide and stopped. OUR PRECIOUSMOMENT trailed after a slow break.
