FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS AND UPWARD. No Nomination Fee, \$1,000 to pass the entry box, \$1,000 additional to start. The purse to be distributed: \$2,000 to all starters, with the balance of the purse to be divided; 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth, 3% to fifth. Weights: Friday, July 24. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. (If deemed inadvisable by management to run this race over the turf course, it will be run on the main track at Five Furlongs.)

Footnotes

CARDASHI was rated in good position inside, edged out on the turn while commencing his rally, reached the front inside the final sixteenth and drove clear. BLUE SAILOR took over just after the break, angled to the rail once clear early on the turn then couldn't withstand the winner late. CHAMBERLAIN BRIDGE wasn't far back outside and finished gamely. LITTLE NICK was unhurried inside, came out between horses in the lane and finished with good energy. SMART ENOUGH wasn't far back, angled to the inside on the turn and lacked a strong closing. YANKEE INJUNUITY was slow to settle, came wide into the stretch and gained to the end. TRUE QUALITY was shuffled back at the break then lagged along the rail into the stretch, came out between horses and gained too late. EUROEARS was slow from the gate, raced three wide around the turn and lacked a closing. SEA DUBAI showed speed briefly between horses then stopped.
