### Footnotes

SOUL PROVIDER stalked the pace from the three path, raced to contention on the far turn, then drew clear in the stretch and finished under urging. GULF WIND was unhurried early, raced inside on the far turn then angled outward entering the stretch, moved to the inside and made a late bid finishing second best. THE HIGH PRIEST was slow early, raced two wide through the far turn then found his best stride late. FANTASTIC OMEN vied for the lead from the start, raced along the inside through the last turn, then weakened late. FRONT STREET was close up and four wide on the first turn, then saved ground on the far turn while making a mild bid. MEMORABLE DISPUTE was close up early, raced three wide through the far turn, then lacked a late response. SHEEBA THE SHARK vied for the early lead, raced three wide through the last turn then faded. DEEBLES POINT vied for the lead from the two path through the second turn then faltered. RONDAS MY MOM pressed the pace from the two path early, then was through after a half. BEN'S JAZZ CLUB lacked speed, raced along the inside through the second turn and was outrun.
