**Footnotes**

DISTINCTIVE INK set the pace from the start, saved ground through the turn with a clear lead and finished under urging. WISE THINKING pressed the pace from the two path through the turn, then was no match for the winner in the drive but was clearly second best. GET THE SCOOP was close up early, raced along the inside on the turn, then lacked a rally in the drive. BLAIR'S PEACE was slow early, saved ground on the turn, then made a mild bid late. SWEET HONEY BEE was close early, raced three wide on the turn and not really a factor. TOUCHDOWN TEBOW showed brief speed, raced two wide on the turn then faltered and was outrun.
