HOPEFUL STAR vied for the lead from the two path through the turn, then drew clear in the stretch and finished under urging. CAMERA SHY pressed the pace from the inside through the turn, made a late bid but was no match for the winner. COPY MOM was close up and three wide on the turn while racing evenly. DIAMOND GLO was never far back, raced three wide through the turn then made a mild bid late. MS. ALIAS SMITH was slow early, saved ground on the turn then found her best stride late. GOODFORYOURHEART was slow early, raced two wide on the turn and failed to menace. DISPUTED MISS was close up early, raced inside on the turn then faded late. UNDER THE SEA vied for the lead from along the inside through the turn, then faltered late. SILVERSATINSLIPPER lacked speed, raced three wide on the turn and was outrun. NO SAX stumbled at the start, raced along the inside on the turn, then was pulled up at the top of the stretch.
