ARTISTA stalked two wide, inherited command just after a half, was clear nearing the far turn then was all out to last. BEAUTIFUL MISSION was unhurried two wide between rivals then slowly closed a gap in deep stretch. BERKLEY STAR was unhurried, moved up two wide between rivals on the final turn then gained late. CLEAR THE DOCKET was slow to settle, raced two wide between rivals around the final turn then made a mild late run between foes. BEL AIR BABE wasn't far back inside early then tired. SPEEDY TRIAL was outrun inside. LITE THE LADY raced three wide around the final turn and failed to menace. SUMMERS HONOUR tired three wide. MAYCOCKS BAY was wide and outrun. VALL AND JAN made the early pace then was pulled up just after a half and walked back to the unsaddling area.
