WARDELLE pressed the pace from the two path, contended on the turn, then drew off while under urging. NEO'S GRAND FINALE was close up and saved ground through the turn, then made a late bid but was no match for the winner. PHOENIX COURT was close up early, saved ground on the turn, then made a mild bid in the stretch. LISA STANNARD was slow early, raced along the three path on the turn then angled out entering the stretch and made a mild gain. RHYME N RHYTHM set the pace from the inside into the turn, then was headed at the 1/4 pole and faded in the drive. ANCHOVY lacked speed, raced along the two path on the turn then angled outward but was not a factor. REIGN SUZANNE showed early speed, raced two wide on the turn then was through after a half and outrun.
