TONY'S BACK set the pace from the start, saved ground with a clear lead throughout and finished in easy fashion. FIREHOUSE WILLIE pressed the pace from the two path through the last turn, then was no match for the winner in the lane. ITZA PURRFECT RIDE was close up early, raced along the inside on the second turn then angled to the outside at the 1/4 pole and made a mild bid late. ZOARES LAND prompted the early pace, raced two wide on the far turn, then faded late. SPINNING OUT was close up on the backstretch, raced three wide on the far turn then faltered. TRAPPIST MONK raced three wide early and failed to menace. LANZIG lacked speed, saved ground through the second turn, then passed one late. LITECORR also lacked speed, raced along the three path on the far turn and was outrun.
