CAPE GIRARDEAU was bumped hard leaving the gate then was unhurried, began a run along the rail nearing the end of the backstretch, came out two wide midway on the turn, took over from the outside nearing the final furlong and widened under urging. FIRE EATER was bumped leaving the gate, gained position in the three path, gave his best in early stretch but couldn't stay with the winner. AL AMIR took at once, stayed out from the rail then tired. FIVE GUNS WEST ducked out into the winner leaving the gate, was slow early while racing two wide then passed tired ones. TOM'S TUITION was outrun. KAPOK tired inside. RAVENS BID steadied along the inside while not far back entering the far turn then tired. DOVER STREET ART (IRE) stayed close on the outside to the far turn then stopped.
