**Footnotes**

STRONG RESOLVE was unhurried early, saved ground on the far turn then angled outward and rallied to draw off while under urging. DISTORTED APPEAL set the pace from the start, saved ground through the last turn, held a clear lead late but was outfinished. SCARLET AND GOLD was slow early, raced three wide on the second turn, then closed ground willingly. WITH BENEFITS was void of early speed, raced three wide on the last turn then made a late bid. CITY STRUT pressed the pace from the two path through the second turn, then weakened in the stretch. NORTH OF ALASKA was close up early, saved ground on the far turn, then tired late. DOVER STREET ART (IRE) raced two wide on the last turn and failed to menace. TAPPS raced along the inside on the second turn and lacked a rally. S W AIDAN lacked speed, raced inside on the far turn and was not a factor. NO PASSAGE lacked speed, saved ground on the second turn and showed little. DUCHMASTER stalked the pace from the start, raced two wide through the second turn, then flattened out in the stretch.
