TRUMATCH was never far back, raced three wide on the turn, then rallied late and drew off under urging. CRASH MAGEE set the pace with a clear lead, saved ground through the turn, then gave way late. SWEET STORM was slow early, raced two wide on the turn, then closed ground willingly. STEINBRENNER stumbled at the start, raced along the inside through the turn, then found his best stride late. FIVE STAR RATING was unhurried early, raced three wide on the turn the made a mild bid late. WHEATON'S WISH was slow early, raced inside on the turn and was not a factor. SNOW JOB pressed the pace early, raced inside through the turn, then weakened in the stretch. SUNTORIOUS showed good early speed, raced two wide on the turn then faltered. GREENBRIER lacked speed, raced two wide on the turn, was through early and outrun.
