FOOD FIGHTIN vied for the lead from the start, then drew clear early and saved ground through the last turn while finishing under encouragement. BARRY MEATBALL pressed the pace from the start, raced three wide on the second turn, then was no match for the winner in the stretch. ONE LESS AFFAIR was close up early, raced along the inside on the second turn, then lacked a late response. TOUR THE PLACE prompted the early pace, raced along the inside on the far turn, then failed to sustain a bid. LEGENDARY BRAVERY was close up early, raced two wide on the last turn, then weakened in the stretch. MANHATTAN RED pressed the early pace, raced three wide on the second turn, then faded in the stretch. TRUE LAD lacked speed, raced two wide on the second turn and showed little. CITY SKY also lacked speed, raced along the inside on the far turn and failed to menace. TWO ON THE AISLE vied for the early lead, then dropped back early and flattened out on the last turn.
