CHANGING VISTA was unhurried early, rallied wide around the turn, closed between rivals through the lane and drew out through late stretch. AUTUMN ASH lagged inside after a slow break then came through tight quarters in midstretch with a late rally. MOON OVER MALIBU stayed close to the inside around the turn, came out from the rail in the stretch but lacked a strong closing. ATLANTIC HILLS moved to the front from the inside midway on the backstretch, came out in the stretch and weakened. CONGA QUEEN raced two wide between rivals around the turn and lacked a rally. LION IN THE SUN wasn't far back outside, bore out on the turn and tired. JULIE FROM DIXIE was outrun three wide. NO ARGUMENT made the early pace, raced two wide around the turn then tired. SOTO'S SURPRISE had early position, raced two wide around the turn then stopped.
