PARK CITY SAM vied for the lead from the three path through the turn, then weakened late. EARLWIN was slow early, raced two wide on the turn, then made a mild bid late. MY SEBY was void of early speed, saved ground on the turn, then passed the tired ones. MUDGIES LAST GEM vied for the lead from the two path through the turn, then faltered late. HOOSIER HOT SHOT vied for the lead from the four path through the turn, then flattened out in the lane.
