KAFWAIN WEDGEHEART set the pace from the start, saved ground and held a clear lead through the second turn, then just lasted while under urging. MAINE INGREDIENT pressed the pace from the three path through the far turn, then rallied late and just missed. BATTLE HARBOUR was unhurried early, raced along the four path on the last turn, then made a late bid. ECHSTEIN VILLAGE was close up and checked entering the first turn, raced along the three path on the far turn then made a mild bid in the drive. SATELLITE BEACH prompted the early pace, raced three wide on the far turn, then weakened in the drive. NAMATH pressed the early pace, raced along the two path on the last turn and faded late. WHY SEVENTEEN stalked the pace from the two path through the second turn, then gave way in the drive. MENIFEE SIX was slow early, raced along the inside on the far turn and failed to menace. LITTLE PEP lacked speed, raced two wide on the second turn and was not a factor. IRISH MAJESTY was close up early, saved ground on the far turn, then was through after a half. DIPLOMATIC LOVER was close up early, raced along the two path on the last turn, then faltered and was outrun.
