Footnotes

RED PETE was unhurried, raced wide around the turn, was brushed repeatedly through the lane and was along in time. AZICHARMYOU was never far back, raced inside the winner around the turn, bore out under left hand whip and repeatedly brushed through one through the lane and finished gamely. BEAR'S PROSPECTOR stayed out from the inside while chasing the early leader, opened a short lead from between horses just before five furlongs then drifted late and gave way. MR. BARRACUDA stayed out from the inside while making the pace into the final furlong then weakened. COCO POINT raced two wide and failed to menace. SIR JOHN broke slowly then was outrun inside.
