ECHSTEIN VILLAGE was rated three wide with the pace, moved clear on the final turn, drew out in early stretch and was under steady urging. RAISE THE CODE settled, raced two wide around the turns, angled out in the lane and finished willingly outside. MASTER DREAMER was unhurried while caught wide around the first turn, gave his best three wide on the final turn then continued evenly through the lane. HIGH TOP SNEAKERS was slow to settle while racing two wide then made a run between horses. FASTEST JAMES was unhurried, raced three wide around the final turn and lacked a strong closing. KALAS dueled two wide for about three quarters then tired. DOUBLE DUTCH BUS lagged early while outrun. RAGING WILD FIRE was outrun. STAYINTHEGAME dueled inside, steadied entering the far turn then stopped. SERENASGO was finished early. BAYWIND MOON stopped and was eased up through the stretch.
