WHO WE GUNNA CALL stayed out from the rail while unhurried early, swung wide into the stretch and drove clear past midstretch. BUNKER HILL was rated in good position, raced three wide around the final turn, vied outside into the final furlong then weakened. PRETTY MR. D stalked the early leader in the three path, took over just before six furlongs then tired in the lane. BATTLEGROUND stayed out from the rail while making the pace for almost three quarters then stopped. NO BRAKES lagged inside then passed tired ones. ALINA'S LAD stopped outside. QUAIL HOLLOW was outrun.
