COOK INLET was never far back, raced along the three path on the second turn, then rallied in the drive and drew off late while under urging. JACK'S THE WON vied for the lead from the two path, drew clear on the far turn, then gave way in the drive. DRAYTON HALL was unhurried early, raced along the inside on the last turn, then closed ground willingly. HURRICANE CREEK was void of early speed, raced along the three path on the second turn, then made a mild bid late. CORK COUNTY was close early, saved ground on the last turn then weakened. LIAM AND ALEX was slow early, raced three wide on the far turn and failed to menace. COURAGE TO BE lacked speed, raced two wide on the second turn and was never a threat. RODERICK vied for the lead from along the inside into the far turn, then faltered and was outrun.
