FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS. No Nomination Fee. \$500 to pass the entry box with an additional \$500 to start. Supplemental nominations of \$2,000 will be accepted at time of entry which shall include all fees. The purse to be distributed: \$1000 to all starters; with the balance of the purse to be divided, 60% to the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth, and 3% to fifth. Weights: 122 lbs. Non-winners of a Sweepstakes at one mile or over in 2012, allowed, 2 lbs.; \$25,000 twice at a mile or over in 2012, 4 lbs.; \$18,000 once at a mile or over in 2012, 6 lbs. (Maiden and Claiming races not considered in estimating allowances). Closed Friday, August 10, 2012 with 35 nominators. (Rail at 0 feet) (If deemed inadvisable by management to run this race over the turf course it will be run on the main track at One Mile. If more than 10 horses remain it will be run at One Mile and Seventy Yards.)

RELAY BILL opened a clear lead soon after the break, stayed along the rail, drew out in early stretch and held under steady urging. MARGANO was unhurried inside, steadied in tight entering the far turn, remained along the rail and gained mildly through the lane. TWO MONTHS RENT trailed early, advanced into tight quarters along the rail approaching the lane, swung out in early stretch and finished with good energy. THOMAS HILL settled early, was caught wide around both turns, was forced out in early stretch then weakened. JUST SAYIN wasn't far back inside early then tired. YOURHONORANDGLORY had early position three wide, was caught in tight between horses in early stretch and flattened out. MASTEREL (ITY) didn't break sharply then moved up between rivals to press the early leader and was tiring when steadied in tight in early stretch. MR. HANDSOME was outrun. GOLDEN WHEELS was steadied in tight entering the first turn, raced two wide and stopped.
