DR SOOZ stalked the pace from along the inside through the turn, contended late then drew off under urging. DEBBIE H vied for the lead from the inside through the turn, then gave way after a long drive. GRANNY MAC pressed the early pace, raced two wide on the turn, then made a mild bid late. DANCE WITH JAMES was never far back, raced three wide on the turn, then closed willingly. YOU DO IT pressed the pace from the three path through the turn while racing evenly throughout. RUNNINGONAPRAYER was close up and two wide on the turn, then lacked a late response. KARMA CHECK vied for the lead from the two path through the turn, then faded in the drive. THE GOLD SHEPHERD saved ground but lacked a rally. WENDY DOLL raced two wide on the turn and showed little. AWE SO BEAUTIFUL lacked speed, raced three wide on the turn and was not a factor. NO IRONING SUNDAY was close up early, raced inside through the turn, then faded in the lane. T T GOURMET trailed throughout.
