PERFECT FOOTPRINT was unhurried early, advanced throughout and was three wide on the far turn then drew clear in the stretch and was ridden out to the wire. TURN TO THE KING pressed the pace from the start, saved ground through the far turn, then made a late but mild bid to be second best. I AM THE KING was close up and four wide on the last turn, rallied mildly in the stretch but was no match for the winner. WILD AND WILEY prompted the pace early, then dropped back and raced along the two path through the last turn, then made a late move. GOOD GENERAL vied for the lead early, raced along the inside and gained command on the last turn, then faded late. CAJUN BAYOU was slow early, raced four wide on the far turn and failed to menace. COFFEE BAR was close up early, raced two wide on the second turn, then faltered in the lane. ACADEMY RUN vied for the lead from along the inside to the second turn then flattened out.
