MYSTIC HARBOR was unhurried early, raced along the inside and advanced steadily through the last turn then angled out at the top of the stretch and drew off late while under mild encouragement. ASKARI vied for the lead from the start, raced two wide through the second turn, entered into a long drive then gave way late. ROUND ABOUT pressed the pace from the two path through the second turn, reached contention late then weakened. LOOKINTOGETOUT was never far back, raced along the inside on the last turn while racing evenly throughout. GAS HOUSE vied for the lead from the start, raced along the inside through the second turn, then faded late. MORE WAYS THAN ONE was close up early, raced three wide on the far turn, then lacked a late response. GREAT HALO lacked speed, raced three wide on the second turn and showed little throughout. CAPE HARBOUR raced two wide on the far turn, was never a threat and was outrun.
