MALIBU RHYTHM was close up from the start, reached contention early then entered into a long drive and drew off in the stretch under urging. RAISE THE CODE was never far back, raced three wide on the second turn, then rallied late and finished second best. PREACHER'S KID set the early pace, then was headed on the backstretch, was engaged in a long drive then gave way in the stretch. CHARLES PRIDGEN was close up early, raced two wide on the far turn, then faded in the stretch. LIDO KEY was slow early, raced two wide on the far turn then made a mild bid late. FIRM GROUND was void of early speed, raced four wide on the last turn and was never a threat. DOUBLE REVIVAL pressed the early pace, raced along the inside through the second turn then faded late. SAMURAI SWORD lacked speed, raced inside on the far turn, then passed the tired ones. DIMITRAKIS was close up early, raced three wide on the far turn then faltered. MIKEY B pressed the early pace from the two path, then weakened on the second turn and was outrun.
