**Footnotes**

PRINCESS MAGOGO was close up and two wide, then reached contention on the second turn and drew clear in the stretch and held well under steady encouragement. NEO'S GRAND FINALE was never far back, raced along the two path through the last turn, then rallied late to be second best. EASTER SERVICE was unhurried early, raced along the inside on the far turn, then put forth a good closing effort. DOWNRIGHT JOYOUS was slow early, then advanced steadily from the inside through the last turn and made a mild bid in the stretch. B MY SECRET set the pace from the start, saved ground to and was headed on the far turn, then gave way in the stretch. SISTER SHARON was close up early, raced two wide on the second turn, then lacked a rally and faded in the stretch. POWERFUL PRESENCE was void of early speed, raced three wide on the second turn, then passed the slow ones. VOL PONNI UP lacked speed, raced along the inside on the turn then angled out but showed little throughout. PEWTER PUNCH showed brief speed, raced two wide on the last turn, then failed to menace. WONDERWONDERWHY stalked the early pace, raced three wide on the second turn, then was through after a half.
