THORIN was unhurried inside, began a run after a half, swung out three wide for room nearing the stretch, came in then came out for room in midstretch and took over in late stretch. PASTAFAGIOLI was slow to settle, was sent up after a half, came out wide on the final turn and finished fast outside. GERMANICUS dueled two wide, angled to the rail entering the far turn then bore out under left hand whip through the lane and couldn't contain the top two late. DUNE DANCER was unhurried, made a run three wide around the final turn, loomed a threat into the final furlong then flattened out. GOING FOR IT was slow early, raced three wide around the final turn and failed to menace. AWESOME LION was unhurried, made a run two wide into the far turn, was steadied midway on the bend and stopped. WISE RANGER dueled inside, steadied entering the far turn, drifted out in front of AWESOME LION midway on the turn then stopped. An objection by Gonzalez against the third finisher was not allowed. GLANCING BLOW was finished early.
