Footnotes

STANDING ALONE in the middle of the pack on the backstretch and along the rail, angled out on the second turn then contended late and was full of run under steady urging. OVAYA saved ground, pressed the pace on the second turn, angled out three wide, gained the lead briefly in midstretch but failed. GOD'S GRACE lacked early speed, advanced steadily to finish well. DUKE'S ENYA was never far back, entered the second turn in the four path and made a mild bid. SLEWINCA saved ground in an even effort. KARLA'S VICTORY set the pace in the early stages, drew off to a clear lead but faded in the final eighth. CORDON NEGRO pressed the pace on the backstretch from along the rail and faltered.
