**Footnotes**

BAREFOOT LANDING was unhurried early, raced inside on the last turn, then angled outward and rallied to draw clear under urging. J D'S FIRECRACKER vied for the lead from the inside through the second turn, then drew clear late before giving way. NIGHTSCAPE was never far back, raced inside through the far turn, then closed ground willing. DAVID K was close up from the start, raced three wide on the second turn, then made a mild bid late. BLACK CHEVRON was close up early, raced two wide on the second turn, then lacked a late response. STARS AND BOOTS vied for the lead from the two path through the far turn, then faltered in the stretch. OUT IN THE REIGN was never far back, raced three wide on the far turn, then lacked a rally late. LIGHTS OUT LIDGE lacked speed, raced along the two path through the far turn, then passed tiring rivals. HARBOR RIDGE raced two wide on the last turn and failed to menace. BLUE LIGHT SPECIAL was close up early, raced three wide on the far turn, then faltered late. TURN TO THE KING was close up early, raced three wide on the second turn then flattened out.
