Footnotes

IN MEMORYOFRIEND was slow early, raced three wide on the last turn, then closed fast and prevailed. READY OR NOT pressed the pace from the two path through the last turn, gained command late then was outfinished. NIGHTSCAPE was never far back, raced inside on the second turn, then made a mild bid late. BREAK THE HABIT was unhurried early, raced inside on the far turn, then angled outward and made a late bid. PHILLY BOUND set the pace from the start, raced along the inside to the far turn, then gave way in the stretch. MAKE THEM BREAK was close up early, raced two wide on the second turn then weakened in the stretch. TWO DOO failed to menace. MOUNTAIN ROUTE raced three wide on the far turn and lacked a rally. CLASSIC FRAN saved ground. FINAL KNOCKOUT saved ground and faded on the second turn. BO DIDDLEY vied for the lead from the two path to the second turn then flattened out. BOONESBOROUGH pulled up early.
