### Footnotes

STAR REDEEMER was unhurried, began a run out from the rail midway on the backstretch, came two wide into the stretch and quickly drew clear from the outside through late stretch. LAW OF THE LAND stayed out from the rail while moving on the turn, took over approaching the stretch, drew out but was little match. STAN'S MONEY was slow to settle, raced two wide between horses into the stretch then gained to the end. THIS BULLS A TRIP weakened inside. BOOTSCOOTINSHUFFLE stayed well out from the rail in an even effort. NICETOSEY'AGAIN fell back after the break, stayed inside and lacked a strong closing. CONSORT raced wide into the stretch and failed to menace. UNCLE PHIL moved clear before going a furlong, stayed inside and tired. TIME CONTROL was outrun. TAP KLASS stopped.
