Footnotes

DANIEL MOON had position inside, came out three wide for room approaching the stretch, closed outside and was up late. JUDGE WELL began a run outside on the backstretch, vied two wide around the final turn, took over before seven furlongs and gave way. LIVE ON THE EDGE was slow to settle, rallied two wide around the final turn and finished willingly between horses. GIANT TALENT wasn't far back outside, came out wide on the final turn and lacked a strong closing. NORTH PARK BAND was slow early, raced wide around the final turn and gained outside. GOGOLEGO steadied in tight soon after the break then made a late run inside. RANDOM STRIKE angled to the inside with the early lead then weakened in the lane. SHOW THE WAY steadied soon after the break, wasn't far back two wide to the stretch then weakened. FIVE GUNS WEST trailed early then made a mild run. COCONUT ZACK tired inside. SWEET RASCAL came in sharply while showing speed from the gate, pressed two wide to the far turn then stopped.
