RUNAWAY SUZANNA was unhurried early, rallied three wide around the final turn, angled in through the stretch, brushed MY ELUSIVE DREAM in midstretch and was clear late. MY ELUSIVE DREAM was unhurried after a slow break, rallied three wide around the final turn, vied inside the winner into the final furlong, was brushed in midstretch and weakened. LATIN JOURNEY was slow to settle, stayed close to the inside around the final turn, came out through the lane and finished with good energy. AKIRA wasn't far back while racing close to the inside, came out leaving the final turn and flattened out. LADY WOLF was slow early, raced three wide into the stretch and gained outside. EASTER SERVICE lagged early then found best stride too late. DREAMLESS showed speed outside, moved clear before a half, remained out from the rail around the final turn then tired. A AND J GIRL was outrun inside. PRINCESS MAGOGO angled to the inside on the final turn then tired. ALBERTHA THE COOK wasn't far back for over three quarters while racing out from the rail then tired. AMAUNET wasn't far back between rivals early then stopped. INDIAN GAL opened a clear lead soon after the break, remained prominent for about a half then stopped suddenly entering the far turn and was eased.
