ALTO COLORADO moved to the front soon after the break, bore out nearing the turn, stayed out from the rail to the stretch and held stubbornly. THE GREAT BANDINI angled to the inside on the backstretch, tried inside the winner through the lane but wasn't enough. DUCHMASTER was unhurried inside, came out in early stretch then continued to get out through the lane while gaining. RUNAWAY BEN was unhurried after a slow break, raced three wide into the stretch then was carried out while closing outside. SQUEAKS MAGEE showed speed outside from the outset then tired. HEREISJRZEALOUS raced two wide and tired. DESERT PEPPER was no factor. COLONEL AVARA was outrun. ROYAL J C trailed.
